



**Junior Opposition Spokesperson on Security Jouvaughnie Byfield Demands Clarity on  
Police-Imposed Curfew in Three Hills, Retreat, Charles Town and Tower Isle.**

**St Mary, Jamaica. May 21, 2025:** Junior Opposition Spokesperson on National Security and Defense Jouvaughnie Byfield is calling on the Jamaica Constabulary Force(JCF) to provide clear and immediate justification for the ongoing curfew imposed in the Three Hills, Retreat, Charles Town and Tower Isle area.

Despite the absence of visible threats or reports of violence, these areas remain under strict curfew, with no apparent police presence enforcing or monitoring the restrictions. Concerned residents are now demanding answers regarding the rationale behind these measures, which have disrupted daily routines and raised serious questions about civil rights and community safety.

"This curfew has been in effect without any stated reason or justification," said Byfield. "We understand the need for security, but imposing such restrictions without communication fosters confusion and frustration among law-abiding citizens."

Returning residents, many of whom have come back to Jamaica seeking peace and stability, are especially affected, with uncertainties about how long these restrictions will last and whether they are necessary.

I am calling on the relevant authorities to engage in open dialogue, present factual reasons for the curfew, and clarify the expected duration of these measures. Transparency in policing is fundamental to maintaining public trust and ensuring the fair and just application of law enforcement policies.
