



Statement by Dr. Angela Brown Burke, Opposition Spokesperson on Foreign and Regional Affairs Regarding the Air India Express Flight Tragedy in Ahmedabad

Kingston, Jamaica. June 12, 2025: The People's National Party is deeply saddened by the catastrophic crash of Air India Express Flight IX-113 in Ahmedabad, India, on June 12, 2025. We extend our profound condolences to the families of all victims, including the Including 53 British nationals, 169 Indian nationals, one Canadian national and seven Portuguese nationals confirmed among the passengers.

Our hearts are with India and every community grieving this unimaginable loss. We wish the sole survivor a speedy recovery and can only imagine the trauma he and his family are experiencing during this time.

We acknowledge the swift efforts of Indian first responders and authorities. The PNP expresses confidence in the ongoing investigation led by Indian agencies, with support from international partners including the U.S. National Transport Safety Board (NTSB). We urge transparency and patience as the world seeks answers.

We echo calls for strengthened global aviation safety measures to prevent future tragedies.
