



### **PNP Mourns the Passing of Boxing Great Mike McCallum**

**Kingston, Jamaica. June 1, 2025:** The People's National Party (PNP) joins the nation in mourning the passing of legendary Jamaican boxer Mike McCallum, who died on Saturday, May 31, 2025.

McCallum, known across the globe as "The Bodysnatcher," was one of Jamaica's finest sporting exports. He made history as the first Jamaican to win a world boxing title and went on to claim championships in three weight divisions, light middleweight, middleweight, and light heavyweight.
